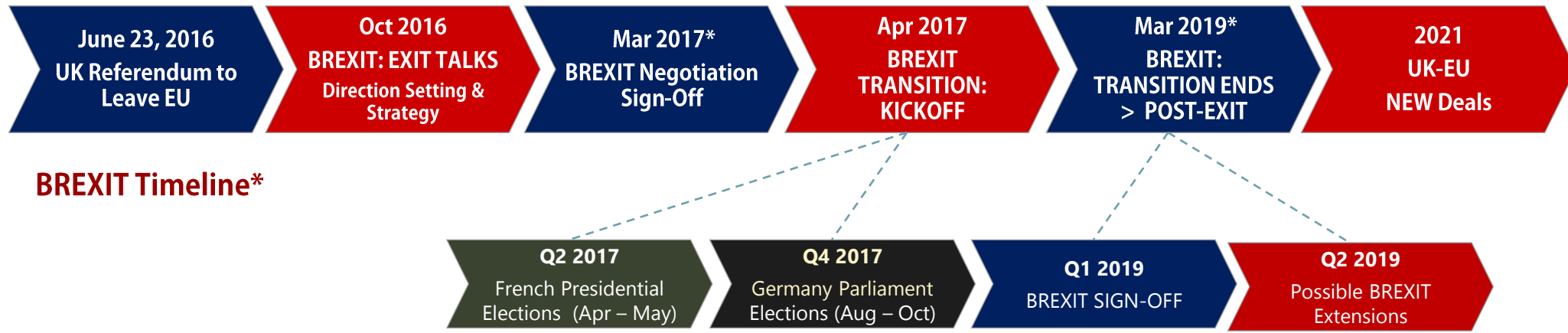

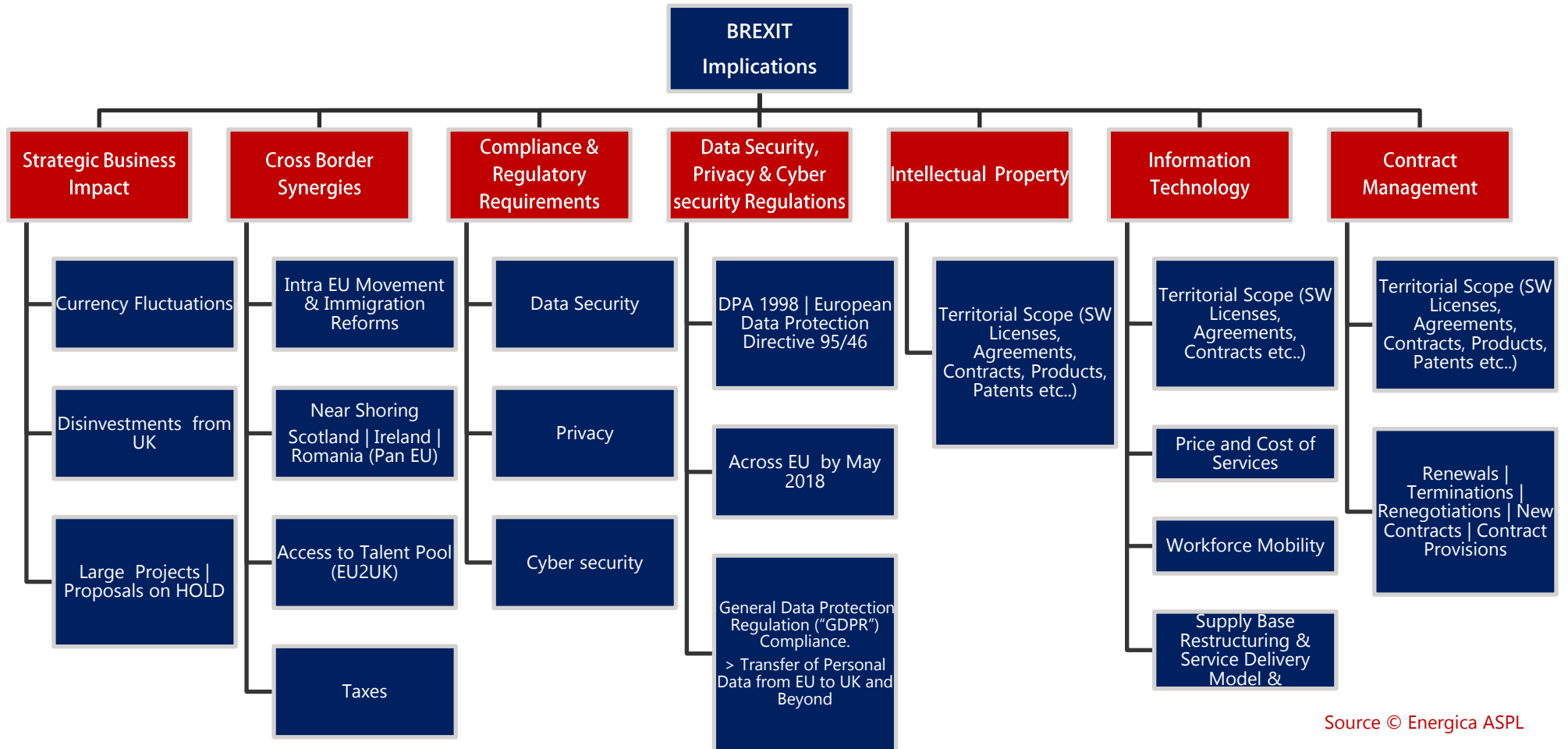

# BREXIT: CHANGING EQUATIONS

## BREXIT: RIPPLING EFFECTS | IT Services | ReSourcing | Technology & Service Innovation

### ▶▶ Currency Fluctuations

- ▶▶ A weak pound therefore has the potential to cut into profit margins;
  - ▶▶ Currency Fluctuations and IT Budget Impact
- ▶▶ Anticipate discretionary budget reductions and have a plan to address these challenges
  - ▶▶ Refresh Business Cases and strategic review priorities by Buyer Organization (Go/No Go/Hold)

### ▶▶ Potential Disinvestment from UK

- ▶▶ Movement across UK and Europe. Movement from UK to other European Country in setting up Business HQ for European Operations rather than operating from UK (loss of Tax Revenue)
- ▶▶ Investment Decisions may be on hold (more specifically on IT Initiatives ) till BREXIT Roadmap emerges

### ▶▶ Access to Talent Pool

- ▶▶ Restricted Access to Talent Pools in the EU (from EU to UK ) ; Stagnation of the Talent Pool resulting in Wage Inflation within UK

### ▶▶ Risk Management

- ▶▶ Regulatory Impact lead to Effective Risk Management (managing and monitoring risks) across BFSI and other Industry segments.

### ▶▶ Near Shoring Approach

- ▶▶ Scotland | Ireland | other EU counties may get momentum for near shoring opportunities.
- ▶▶ Scottish independence referendum\* may likely to be succeed; then it may attract Near Shoring Opportunities for both UK and EU countries\*

### ▶▶ Intra-EU Movement and Immigration Reforms\* may provide prospective opportunities for Non-EU Countries more specifically India

### ▶▶ Exiting from EU will have an impact on Compliance and Regulatory Requirements

### ▶▶ India-UK Relationship Continuum in the Long Term

- ▶▶ Offshore Vendors rely on the ability to move resources to deliver scalability

### ▶▶ Short Term Impact on India based Service Providers

- ▶▶ Spending Decisions on Vital Projects may be on Hold
- ▶▶ Planned Projects may be scrapped rather than simply deferred
- ▶▶ Larger transformational initiatives that require considerable effort to modernize IT infrastructure and application architectures to get put on hold

### ▶▶ Digital Transformation

- ▶▶ Spending on Customer-facing digital technologies will continue to grow

- ▶▶ Access to Visa | Dependency Constraint
- ▶▶ Changes in Service Delivery Model (near shore , onshore, offshore and resource spread mix across UK and Europe)
- ▶▶ Work Visas and Travelling Costs (between UK and Europe) for the customer who is operating across both UK and EU
- ▶▶ DPA and Cloud Data Strategy across UK and Europe; Impact on CSPs operating from UK/EU and across UK/EU and work across both countries (UK and EU) => Visa Restrictions and Entry constraints
- ▶▶ Free Movement provisions into and out of Britain
  - ▶▶ EU Workers Hired to work in UK — Visa free EU Nationals
  - ▶▶ British Citizens hired to work in EU (EEA)
  - ▶▶ Work Permit
- ▶▶ Data Center Relocations to EU from UK
- ▶▶ Offshore — Near shore GIC (Captives) for UK based customers will increase
- ▶▶ Service Delivery automation resulting an increase in IT , RPA and Cognitive Automation
- ▶▶ Near Shoring Approach
  - ▶▶ Scottish independence referendum may likely to be succeed; then it may attract Near Shoring Opportunities for both UK and EU countries
- ▶▶ Cyber Security
  - ▶▶ The Cyber Security Directive - Security Obligations for Online Market Places , Search Engines and cloud Services from 10 May 2018
- ▶▶ Data Privacy
  - ▶▶ New EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) from 25 May 2018
- ▶▶ Data Governance | Data Management
  - ▶▶ Identify where all your data is physically hosted, and who is accessing it
  - ▶▶ Data Location Strategy
  - ▶▶ Data Placement Strategy inline wrt Regulatory exposure or Risk
  - ▶▶ Risk Mitigation & Contingency Planning
- ▶▶ Supplier Governance
  - ▶▶ Supplier BCP-DR | VCRA | Contract Management
  - ▶▶ Refresh your IT sourcing and location strategies together in light of the GDPR rules as well as the EU' s Network and Information Security Directive and currency fluctuations to de-risk your Brexit scenarios.
- ▶▶ Disclosure and Reporting Requirements
  - ▶▶ Brexit-related risk factors and reporting mechanism as a part of the governance and corporate reports.

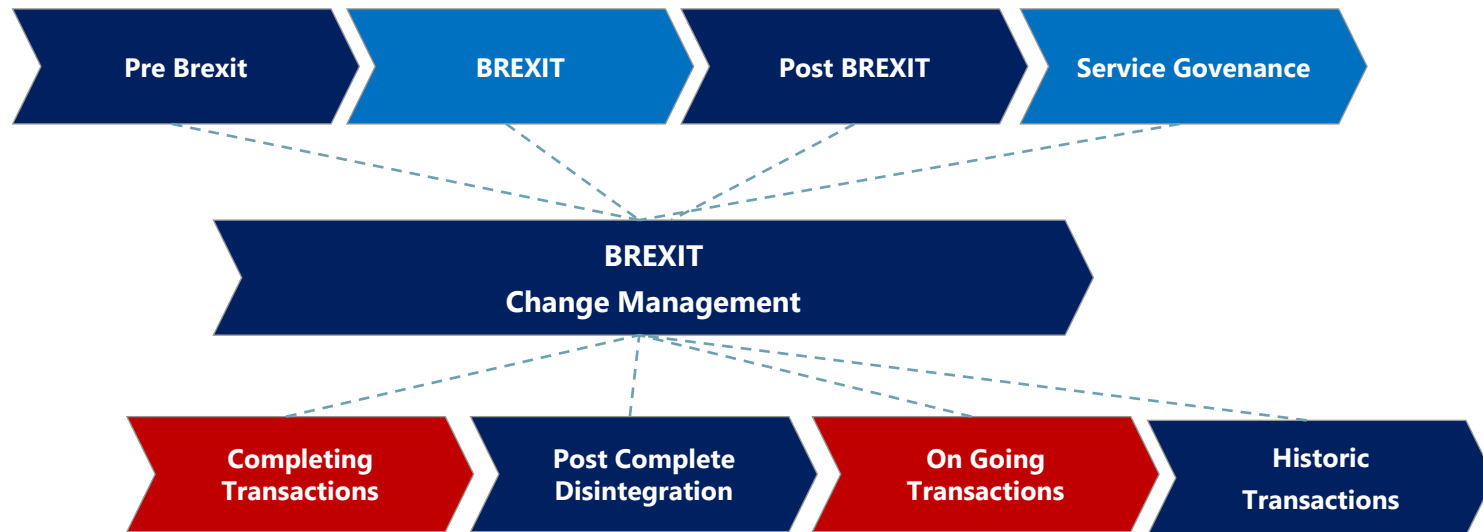

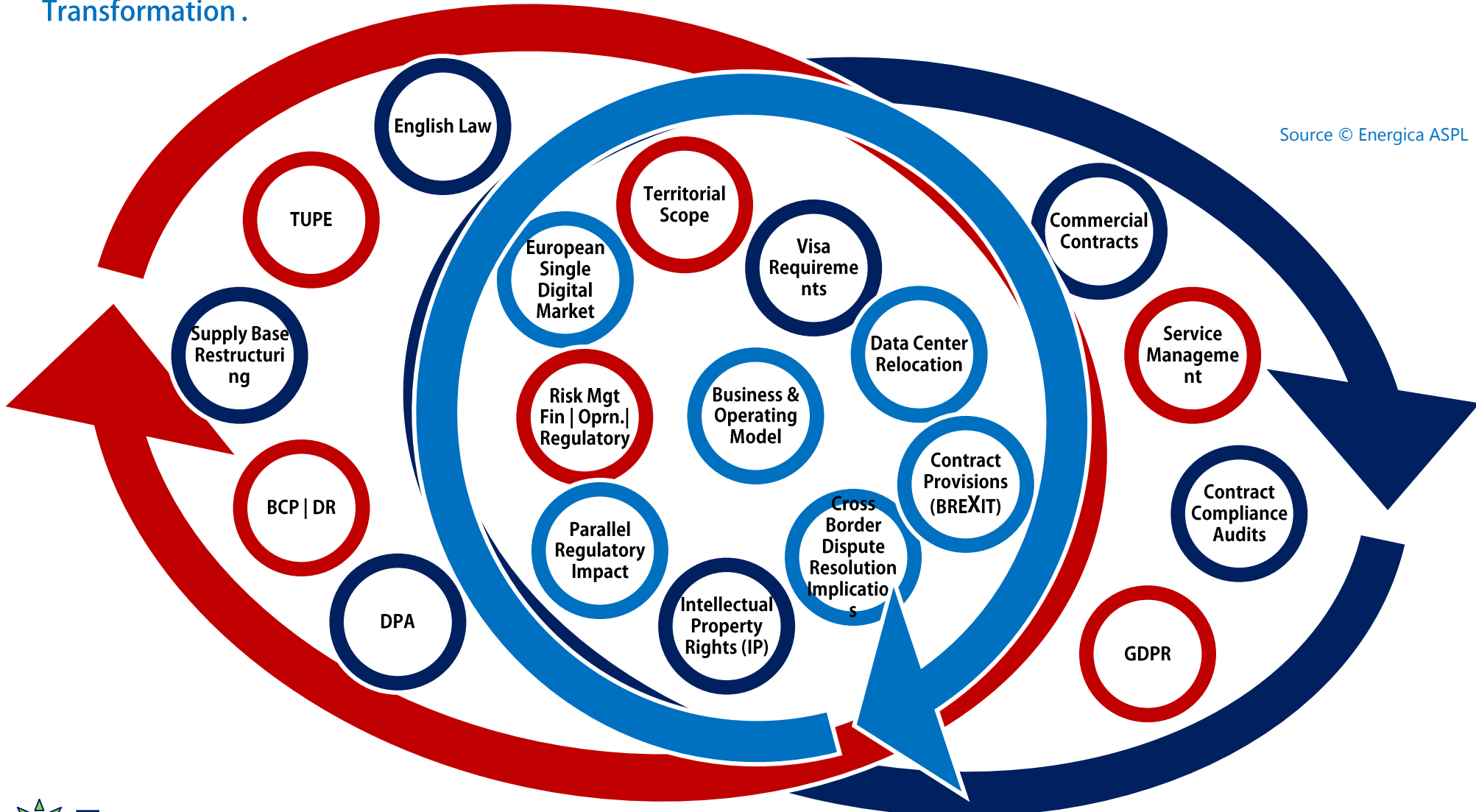

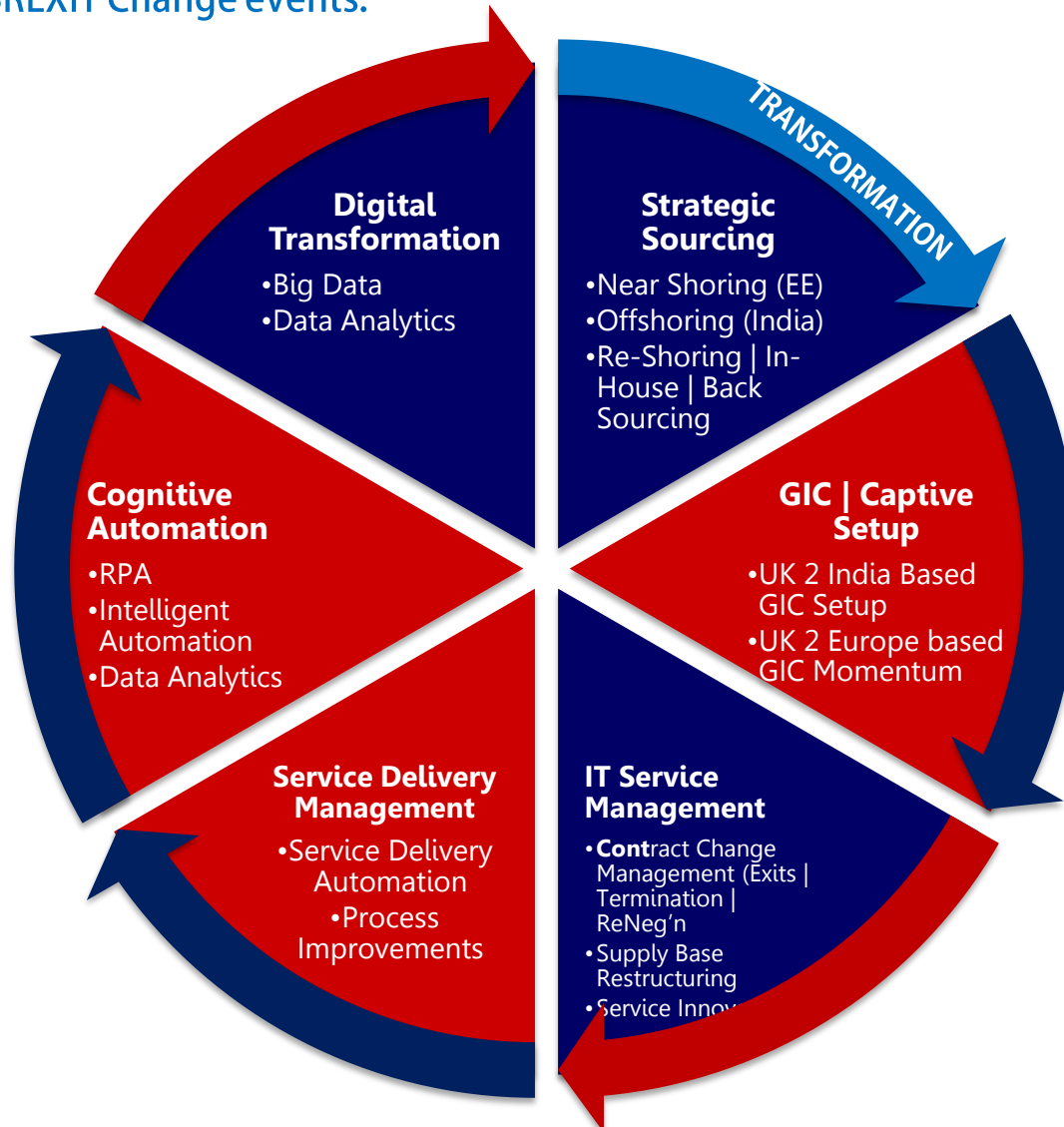

### ■ BREXIT: IT Services - Contract Change Management & Supply Base Restructuring



- ▶▶ \* Highlighted are indicative scenarios. The indicated treatment and the anticipated outcome will vary for every client organization depend on a number of factors unique to each matter w.r.t BREXIT events.
- Amendments\* on existing contracts and contract provisions (during & post BREXIT changes) that should be included in future contracts w.r.t forthcoming BREXIT events.
- Termination\* of your existing contracts\*
  - Termination of a contract will depend very much on the particular terms and specific facts. (due to BREXIT events)
    - EU as the Territorial Scope — To be evaluated in your existing contract
    - New Agreements - BREXIT Specific Material Adverse Changes (MAC) , Force Majeure clauses that are linked to Termination rights and implications on the commercial viability of the commercial arrangement
- Contract Renewals\* | Restructuring\* | Renegotiations\* (PAN EU) may happens on IT Services
  - Lead to smaller, short-term deals revolving around AD services
  - However Renewals of current service agreements or contracts may face uncertainty due to legal framework implications for UK based buyer organizations (adapting to new UK laws — though it is going to be the same or replica of exiting EU with customized changing conditions + TUPE
- ▶▶ Contract Change due to BREXIT events may impact on offshore vendors due to long term annuity based contracts and provide possible potential opportunities for UK and European Players like Capita, Tieto, CSC. Atos etc..

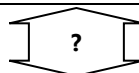
